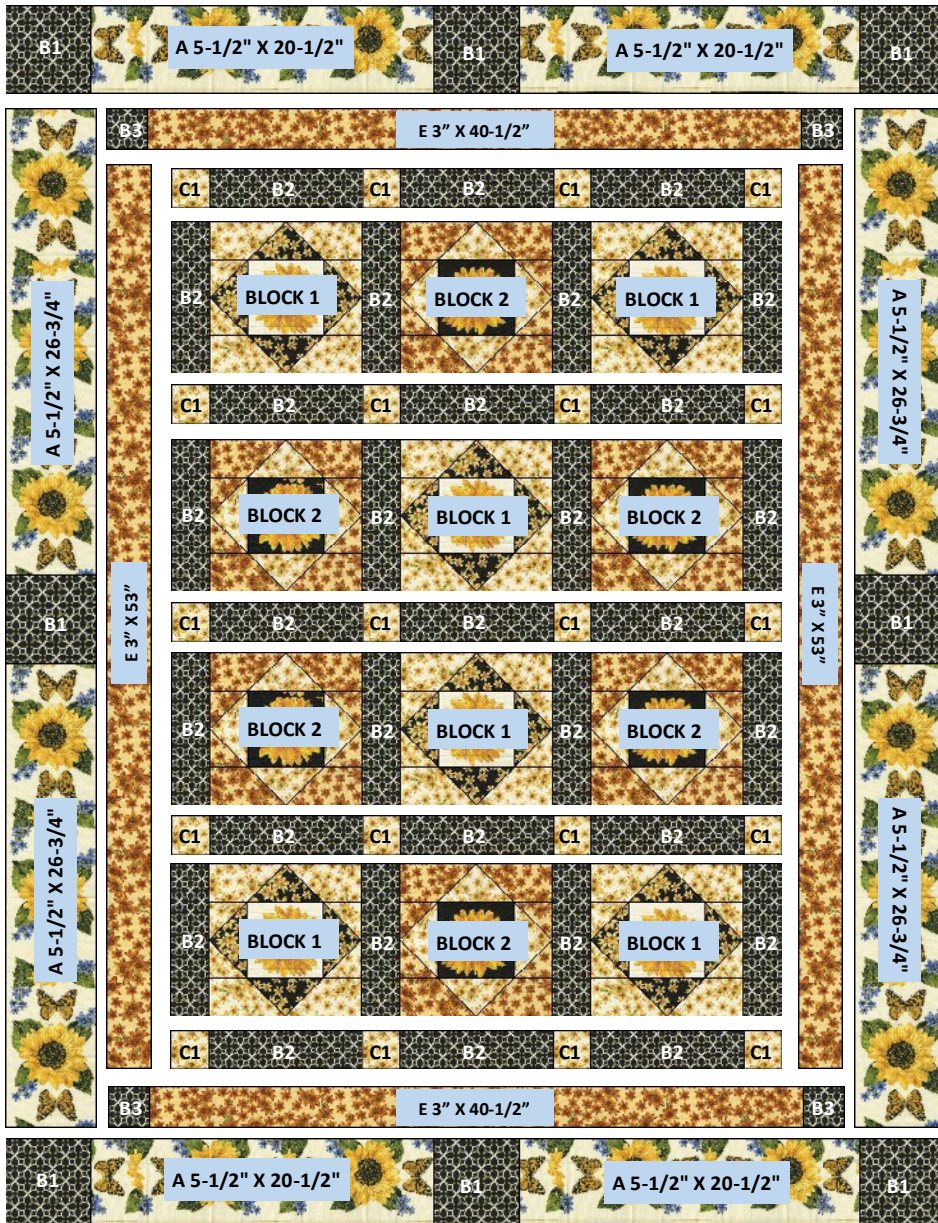


**SUNFLOWER PICNIC QUILT DIAGRAM**  
**FINISHED SIZE: 55" X 68"**



**FINISHING:** Cut batting and backing 3" larger than top on all sides. Layer backing, batting and top together and baste or pin. Quilt as desired. When quilting is completed, trim excess batting and backing. Bind as usual.

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



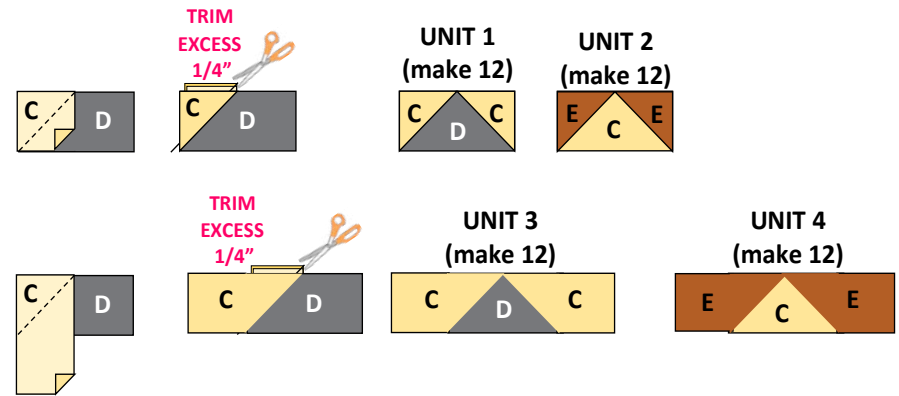

	B 4854M-07 Cross Lattice Black/Cream	1 3/4 YD	(2) 5-1/2" X WOF strip, subcut: (8) 5-1/2" squares (B1) (11) 3" X WOF strips, subcut: (31) 3" X 10-1/2" strips (B2) (4) 3" squares (B3) (7) 2-1/4" strips, BINDING
	C 4912M-07 Blue Delphinium Cream/Gold	1 YD	(11) 3" X WOF strips, subcut: (48) 3" X 5-1/2" rectangles (48) 3" squares (C1)
	D 4912M-12 Blue Delphinium Black/Gold	1/2 YD	(4) 3" X WOF strips, subcut: (24) 3" X 5-1/2" rectangles
	E 4912M-88 Blue Delphinium Rust	1 YD	(6) 3" X WOF strips, subcut: (24) 3" X 5-1/2" rectangles (24) 3" squares (5) 3" X WOF strips*, BORDER
	F 4921M-07 Spaced Sunflower Cream	1/3 YD +	(6) 5-1/2" squares (fussy cut)
	G 4921M-12 Spaced Sunflower Black	1/3 YD +	(6) 5-1/2" squares (fussy cut)

WOF=WIDTH OF FABRIC @ = DIRECTIONAL FABRIC + = EXTRA FABRIC ALLOWED FOR FUSSY CUTTING  
\* SEW STRIPS VIA SHORT ENDS THEN GO TO BORDER ASSEMBLY

### UNIT ASSEMBLY: Refer to **UNIT DIAGRAMS**

- UNIT 1:** Draw a diagonal line on wrong side of (1) C 3" square. Place C square in corner of (1) D 3" X 5-1/2" rectangle, sew on diagonal line. Press C open towards D corner. Trim excess fabric on reverse side to 1/4". Repeat on other side. Square to 3" X 5-1/2". Make (12) **UNIT 1**.
- UNIT 2:** Repeat step 1 using (2) E 3" squares and (1) C 3" X 5-1/2" rectangle. Make (12) **UNIT 2**.
- UNIT 3:** Draw a diagonal line on wrong side of (1) C 3" X 5-1/2" rectangle. Place C square in one corner of (1) D 3" X 5-1/2" rectangle and sew on diagonal line. Press C open towards D corner. Trim excess fabric on reverse side to 1/4". Repeat on other side. Square to 3" X 10-1/2". Make (12) **UNIT 3**.
- UNIT 4:** Repeat step 1 using (2) E 3" X 5-1/2" rectangles and (1) C 3" X 5-1/2" rectangle. Make (12) **UNIT 4**.

### UNIT DIAGRAMS

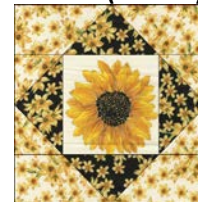


### BLOCK ASSEMBLY: Refer to **BLOCK IMAGES**

- BLOCK 1:** Sew (1) UNIT 1 to each side of (1) F 5-1/2" square, then sew (1) UNIT 3 to top and bottom. Square to 10-1/2", make (6).
- BLOCK 2:** Sew (1) UNIT 2 to each side of (1) G 5-1/2" square, then sew (1) UNIT 4 to top and bottom. Square to 10-1/2", make (6).

### QUILT ASSEMBLY: Refer to **QUILT DIAGRAM** and **COVER IMAGE** for proper block placement and rotation.

- Sew pieces/blocks into horizontal rows as shown on **QUILT DIAGRAM**, then sew rows together.

### BORDER ASSEMBLY: Measure width and length of quilt top to ensure border cutting sizes. Below are **our measurements**.

- BORDER #1:** Sew (1) E 3" X (53") strip to each side. Then sew (1) B 3" square to each side of (1) E 3" X (40-1/2") strip to create top/bottom border strip. Make (2), sew to top and bottom of quilt.
- BORDER #2:** Sew (1) B 5-1/2" square between (2) A 5-1/2" X 26-3/4" strips to create side border unit. Make (2), sew to sides of quilt. Then sew (3) B 5-1/2" squares and (2) A 5-1/2" X 20-1/2" strips together to create top/bottom border unit. Make (2), sew to top and bottom of quilt.
