BLOCK ASSEMBLY PROJECT USES PRECISE 1/4" SEAMS. TEST YOUR SEAM ALLOWANCE BY CUTTING (2) 2-1/2" X 5" RECTANGLES. STITCH THEM TOGETHER ALONG THE 5" LENGTH. AT THE MIDPOINT, MEASURE ACROSS THE UNIT. IT SHOULD BE EXACTLY 4-1/2" WIDE. IF NOT, ADJUST YOUR SEAM ALLOWANCE AND REPEAT.

**BLOCK ASSEMBLY** (Note: Small arrows in figures denote fabric direction.) **1.** Place (1) 6-1/2" **B** square on the top left corner of (1) 12-1/2" **A** square, right sides together. Sew across the diagonal of the smaller square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner. Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle 1/4" away from the sewn seam.

**2.** Follow figure for the seam direction to add a 6-1/2" **B** square to each of the remaining corners of the 12-1/2" **A** square to make (1) **A-block**.









3. Repeat Steps 1-2 to make (4) A-blocks total.

**4.** Using the quilt layout for fabric placement and seam direction, repeat Steps 1-2 to make (8) **C-blocks**, (4) **F-blocks**, (4) **G-blocks**, (5) **Large I-blocks**, (8) **Small I-blocks** and (8) **Small K-blocks**.


## **QUILT ASSEMBLY**

- **5.** Sew (4) **Small K-blocks** and (4) **Small L-blocks** together, alternating them, to make (1) row. Repeat to make a second row. Sew (1) 2-1/2" x 64-1/2" J strip to the top and bottom of the two rows to make (2) **J-border strips**.
- **6.** Sew (5) assorted blocks together to make (1) **Row**. Repeat to make (5) **Rows**.
- **7.** Sew the (5) **Rows** together to make the quilt top.
- **8.** Sew (1) 60-1/2" **J** strip to each side of the quilt top.
- **9.** Sew (1) **J-border strip** to the top and to the bottom of the quilt top.

**FINISHING** Cut batting and backing 3" larger than top on all sides. Layer backing, batting and top together and baste or pin. When quilting is completed, trim excess batting and backing. Bind as usual.
