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






	<b>A</b> Texture 3987-23 <i>Orange</i>	7/8 YD	(2) 14 1/2" x WOF strips, subcut (4) 14 1/2" squares
	<b>B</b> Texture 3987-01 <i>Pink</i>	7/8 YD	(2) 14 1/2" x WOF strips, subcut (4) 14 1/2" squares
	<b>C</b> Texture 3987-44 <i>Lime</i>	7/8 YD	(2) 14 1/2" x WOF strips, subcut (4) 14 1/2" squares
	<b>D</b> Slices 3986M-01 <i>Pink</i>	3/4 YD	(2) 12 1/2" x WOF strips, subcut (6) 12 1/2" squares <i>(from squares you will need to create 12" circles for applique using the method of your choice. If your method is folding over the edges, please allow an extra 1/4" for seam allowance.)</i>
	<b>E</b> Frames 3983M-44 <i>Lime/Aqua</i>	3/4 YD	(2) 12 1/2" x WOF strips, subcut (6) 12 1/2" squares <i>(from squares you will need to create 12" circles for applique using the method of your choice. If your method is folding over the edges, please allow an extra 1/4" for seam allowance.)</i>
	<b>F</b> Scroll 3985M-22 <i>Yellow</i>	5/8 YD	(4) 4 1/2" x WOF strips*; SASHING
	<b>G</b> Quilt Block Solids 3000H-12 <i>Black</i>	7/8 YD	(6) 4 1/2" x WOF strips, subcut (48) 4 1/2" squares
	<b>H</b> Chain Links 3989-12 <i>Black</i>	1-1/2 YD	(6) 2 1/2" x WOF strips*, OUTER BORDER (7) 2 1/2" x WOF strips*, BINDING

WOF = WIDTH OF FABRIC / \* = NEEDS TO BE PIECED

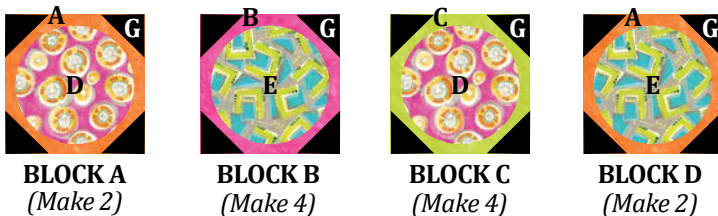
### BLOCK ASSEMBLY

This quilt is made up of 4 different blocks sewn together in rows between sashing strips.

1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) **G** 4 1/2" square. Place square, right sides together in one corner of (1) **A** 14 1/2" square. Sew on drawn line. Trim 1/4" away from drawn line and press open to reveal corner triangle. Repeat on the remaining 3 corners of the square to create **AG SQUARE**.



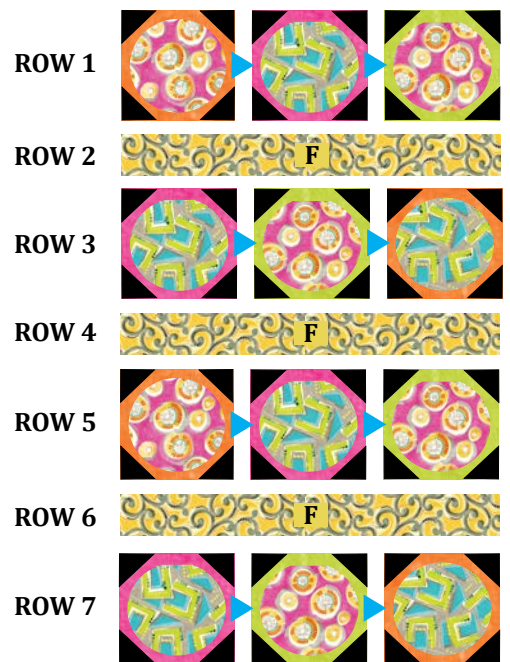
3. Repeat steps 1 and 2 for **BLOCKS B, C, and D** replacing fabrics as shown in the diagrams below.



### QUILT ASSEMBLY

4. Sew blocks together in rows. Sew rows and sashing strips together into quilt center as shown in diagram on the top right.

**ROWS 1 & 5: BLOCK A > BLOCK B > BLOCK C**  
**ROWS 3 & 7: BLOCK B > BLOCK C > BLOCK D**  
**ROWS 2, 4, & 6: (1) F 4-1/2" x 42-1/2" strip**

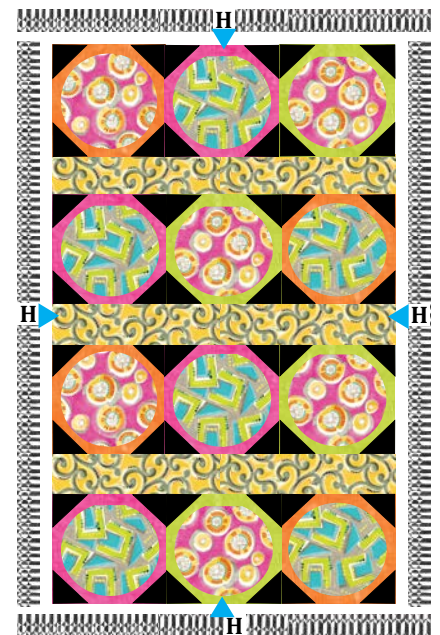


### BORDER ASSEMBLY

MEASURE WIDTH AND LENGTH OF THE QUILT TOP TO ENSURE BORDER SIZES, BELOW ARE OUR CUTTING SIZES.

**5. OUTER BORDER:** Sew (1) **H** 2 1/2" x 68 1/2" border strip to each side of quilt center. Sew (1) **H** 2 1/2" x 46 1/2" border strip to the top and bottom of quilt center.

### QUILT DIAGRAM



**FINISHING :** Cut batting and backing 3" larger than top on all sides. Layer backing, batting and top together and baste or pin. When quilting is completed, trim excess batting and backing. Bind as usual.

Finished Quilt Size: 46" W x 72"L
